Information Sheet: Tarot Guidance

There are 3 parts to the Tarot, reflecting 3 aspects of life:

- 1) Court Cards – levels of energy (see more information below)
 - a. Corresponds to energy levels through the day and in our personal lives
 - b. Also corresponds to people in our lives

- 2) Minor Cards – stages of creativity – Tarot Numerology
 - a. One (Ace) – beginnings, unity, initiation
 - b. Two – duality, choice, relationships
 - c. Three – synthesis, expansion, birth
 - d. Four – stability, order, possession
 - e. Five – mediation, challenge, struggle
 - f. Six – harmony, equilibrium, progress
 - g. Seven – tests, victory, commencement
 - h. Eight – ebb and flow, prioritizing, change
 - i. Nine – attainment, completion, reflection
 - j. Ten – the infinite, perfection, beginnings and endings

- 3) Major Arcana Cards – Universal patterns
 - a. Corresponding to universal archetypes.

The 4 Suits correspond to the 4 contexts of life, and the 4 elements

- 1) Pentacles – earth – I can....., or I have....., resources – environmental, people, internal skills and abilities, financial (Winter)
- 2) Cups – water – I feel....., emotions, intuition, feelings, imagination, merging (Spring)
- 3) Swords – air – I Think....., thoughts, ideas, words, intellect, clarity, conflict, judgement (Fall)
- 4) Wands – fire – I Want....., values, passions, ambitions, vision, desire, challenge, careers (Summer)

Court Cards:

- 1) Kings – Fire, masculine, mature, pinnacle, demonstrating, creativity
 - a. King of Wands – Fire/Fire – lightning flashes, demonstrating values
 - b. King of Cups – Fire/Water – rains, springs, solutions, demonstrating emotions
 - c. King of Swords – Fire/Air – rushing forth, storms, demonstrating ideas
 - d. Kind of Pentacles – Fire/Earth – earthquakes, maintaining, demonstrating resources



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- 2) Queens – Water, feminine, mature, nurturing, inspiring, channelling
 - a. Queen of Wands – Water/Fire – fluidity, colour of fire, connecting values
 - b. Queen of Cups – Water/Water – reception and reflection, connecting emotions
 - c. Queen of Swords – Water/Air – air’s power of transmission, connecting ideas
 - d. Queen of Pentacles – Water/Earth – mother earth, abundance – connecting resources

- 3) Knights (Prince) – Air, youth, question, seeking, challenging, actions, active manifesting
 - a. Knight of Wands – Air/Fire – expanding and volatizing fire, conflict of values
 - b. Knight of Cups – Air/Water – elasticity, volatility, catalyst, conflict of emotions
 - c. Knight of Swords – Air/Air – pure air, penetrating, conflict of ideas
 - d. Knight of Pentacles – Air/Earth – fruitification of earth, solid, grounded, conflict of resources.

- 4) Page (Princess) – Earth, awakening, beginnings children, instigating, insecurity, raw, self-doubt, new energy
 - a. Page of Wands – Earth/Fire – fuel for fire, transition of values
 - b. Page of Cups – Earth/Water – crystallization, transition of emotions
 - c. Page of Swords – Earth/Air – fixation of the volatile, transition of ideas
 - d. Page of Pentacles – Earth/Earth – kingdom, foundation, transition of resources.
